Life App Definition

Confidence is learning to see yourself the way God sees you.

Main Idea

In *Judges 6-8*, we discover more about when God called Gideon to lead the Israelites. Gideon doubted God would want him to help. After all, Gideon was from the smallest tribe, the smallest family, and he was the smallest of his family! God wanted him anyway. Eventually, Gideon learned that God could use him no matter what! Big or small, young or old, God can use people to do extraordinary things. We pray that whether kids feel like Gideon or have the confidence of an entertainer taking the stage, kids will realize that God can use them.

Memory Verse

I remain confident of this: I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Psalm 27:13

Bottom Line

God can use you no matter what.

Activity Rotation: "Opposite Day" (emphasis on the opposite of confidence) The idea of this game is that Gideon had the opposite of confidence, which was fear!! The emphasis of this game is on "opposites" and how things become opposite when God has a plan!

- You and your child will take turns playing this guessing game.
- Tape one of the "Opposite Day Cards" on you or your child's back.
- The other player will give hints about the word on their back but it's opposite day so the player has to correctly guess the **opposite** of the word on their back.
- Remind your child, if necessary, that they're trying to get the guesser to say the opposite of the word on their back.
- Take turns through all the words.
